CLASSES

Bubbas (18m-3.5 Years)

All of the fun of jazz, ballet & creative movement in one 30 minute class. This class is for children as young as 18 months to 3.5 years of age who are taking their first steps into dance. This class is ideal for students who have a few years before going to school. Inspiring their creativity through dance and props and games your child will learn some of the basic fundamentals of dance. For this class only, parents are welcome to stay and watch from the door. (depending on current covid restrictions)

Twinkle Toes (3.5-5years)

We offer Ballet, Jazz, Tap & Acro for this age group. Twinkle Toes classes are best suited for students the year before they go off to big school. These classes offer more structure, variety, socialisation and technique whilst preparing them for the transition into Junior classes.

BALLET (20min)

The perfect class for your aspiring little Angelina Ballerina or Emma Wiggle. Our ballet class combines basic classical techniques with imagination and role-playing activities in a beautiful introduction to dance.

JAZZ (20min)

A fun filled, high energy class where little groovers will learn basic dance moves and routines whilst having fun and engaging with other students.

TAP (20min)

Aspiring tappers will develop a sense of rhythm, coordination and timing along with the added fun of tap shoes.

Jazz

Jazz incorporates many technical elements of dance including kicks, turn, turns, leaps and flexibility danced to funky, upbeat music and choreography. Benefits of this class include improved strength, flexibility and confidence. This is one of our most popular styles and is a perfect class to take if your child is just starting out their dance journey.

Lyrical

Lyrical dance is an expressive style derived from jazz and ballet techniques. This genre tells a story through movements and is perfect for children who love to express themselves and will help bring confidence out in those who are a little reserved.

Hip-Hop

Hip Hop is a clear favourite at Alive and it's easy to see why. Hip-Hop incorporates a variety of sub-genres including popping, locking, isolations, break- dance, commercial and many more. Students are constantly being challenged with crazy new moves and everyone always comes out with a smile on their face.

Ballet R.A.D

Ballet is the foundation of all dance genres and has an emphasis on technique and grace. The benefits of classical ballet include posture, discipline, respect and poise.

This is a fundamental genre to take if your child aspires to become more advanced and excel in other genres.

Our ballet classes focus on technique and becoming a stronger, more refined dancer.

Musical Theatre

A very popular class with our students which allows them to explore their creativity and embrace character roles. Musical theatre combines dance with acting and culminates in an amazing end of year production. Past productions include Peter Pan, Wizard Of Oz, The Lion King and Mary Poppins

Tap

In our tap classes we teach classic tap technique seen in musicals like 42nd street and Singing in the rain as well as more current, funky styles such as Tap Dogs.

In this class you make music with your feet and learn rhythm, timing, percussion and patterns.

Cheerleading

An upbeat and energetic combination of dance, acrobatics and stunting. This genre encourages and promotes team work and trust. Currently becoming increasingly more popular from the Netflix show 'Cheer' this is one not to miss in 2022!

Acro

Acrobatic Dance, or Acro as it is commonly referred to by dance professionals, is the beautiful fusion of classic dance technique and the precision and athleticism of acrobatic elements. Acro is an especially challenging style for dancers to master as training in both dance and acrobatic elements is required. Acro technique includes balancing, limbering, tumbling and partnering, based in flexibility, contortion and strength.

Miss Alyssa is a qualified Acrobatic Arts Instructor and follows the Acrobatic Arts syllabus to ensure the safety of our students.



UNIFORMS

We sell all of our uniform items directly through the studio. Students are encouraged to purchase our uniform. Students not in uniform must wear appropriate plain black active wear.

PRIVATE TUITION

Private Tuition is available for students who are driven and passionate and want to improve their technique. They have the opportunity to compete in Eisteddfods throughout the year. Students are required to take ballet to have a solo (except tap and hip hop). These spots fill up very fast so first in best dressed.

CHEERLEADING

Cheerleading has been split into 2 groups to allow for more specialised training and stunts.

Cheerleading A: No pre-requisites

Cheerleading B: Round off and standing bridge required

HIP HOP CREW

Invite Only.

This class will be a combination of ages and students who show potential in hip-hop. The crew will be invited to perform at events and 1 eisteddfod at the end of the year.

PRE-POINTE/POINTE CLASS

Open for ballet students Year 5+

Students will work towards going onto pointe in this class.

A-TEAM

Invite Only.

Our Eisteddfod Program is designed and is suited for those dancers who are driven and passionate about dance. Our program will not only allow you to improve your performance ability, skills and overall confidence, you will become a part of a community that shares the same passion, love and dedication to dance you do! Teams will compete in approx 2-3 eisteddfods per year depending on their progress. Each age group will aim to learn 2 routines. Students will also be required to purchase a \$80 representative jacket.

To be eligible for the team students must take ballet and a minimum of 2 other classes per week.

TERMS & CONDITIONS 2024

I understand that all fees are payable whether my child attends or not.

Fees are invoiced at the commencement of each term and MUST be paid within two weeks of the invoice issue date. Payments can be made either by EFT or cash (correct amount in an envelope marked with the students details.)

A late fee of \$5/week will be charged if this is not paid on time for each week overdue without a payment plan being placed.

A non-refundable payment for insurance and registration will be charged at the time of enrolment. Each student will need to enrol at the beginning of each calendar year and pay this fee. The current enrolment fee is \$35/student or \$45/family.

No parents/guardians/siblings are permitted to stay within the studio at any time during class, unless advised otherwise by our teachers.

Parents are to collect their child from the studio after each lesson. Teachers are not responsible for the students safety before or after class. Please talk with your children about safety and staying inside the premises. Please advise the studio of any family situations we need to be aware of.

All outstanding fees must be paid in full prior to the end of year concert and costumes being distributed or the student will not be permitted to perform. No refunds will be given once costumes are paid for.

Alive Dance Academy accepts no responsibility for lost property or valuables. It is best to leave items these at home and not bring them to dancing.

No bullying or disrespectful behaviour will be tolerated at Alive Dance Academy. All students must treat their teachers and fellow students with respect at all times.
